- Order your Cap & Gown**
BY MARCH 21
Get your official Lehigh Brown & White regalia.

BY WEEK OF MARCH 27
Sign up for a portrait session now (last week of sittings is March 27) to be featured in Lehigh's official yearbook, the *Epitome*.
- Apply for Graduation**
BY APRIL 24
Must complete to receive your Lehigh degree and participate in the ceremony.

- RSVP for Commencement**
BY APRIL 25
To walk the stage and hear your name read, you will need to RSVP.
- Get Your GradPass**
AVAILABLE STARTING THE WEEK OF MAY 8
